For A Stress-Free Recital

- Parents are **NOT** allowed backstage. Our staff & volunteers will help with costume changes.
- Students **are required** to stay backstage until their show has ended. Each show is 60 minutes or less.
- **Only water bottles are allowed backstage.**
- There are scheduled breaks between shows for students to go outside and have a snack with family. Food is not allowed in the theatre.
- Students must arrive with hair & makeup done, and their first costume on with a coverup.
- Students **ages 10 and under are not allowed** to bring makeup for touch ups. Studio will provide makeup for touch-ups.
- Students may bring a book to read backstage while waiting to perform. **Electronics, colors, markers, etc. are not allowed.**
- Label **EVERYTHING** with student's name.
- Each RDA family will receive the professional digital recital video link via email about 2 weeks after the show. This is part of the recital fee and shareable with your extended family. It should **not be put on social media.**
- Preordered recital bouquets can be picked up at the recital. There will be a limited number of red rose bouquets available for purchase at the show.
- Please limit your exits during the recital to **emergencies only**, and only during the blackouts between songs.

Our students have worked all year to give you a wonderful performance. Please show them the same respect you would a professional touring Broadway show. Feel free to cheer and applaud at any time during the dances. Your enthusiasm encourages the children to smile, dance, and have fun!

For Younger Students

- Restrict fluids and food the hour before the start of the recital.
- Take children to the restroom before checking them in.

General Information & Tips

- No underwear under tights.
- No jewelry.
- No nail polish.
- Pin sashes and belts to costume.
- Tuck in ballet shoe "whiskers".
- Double knot shoelaces.
- Safety pin halter tops.

Makeup Tips for the Stage

- **Foundation**

Use an oil free foundation to match your skin tone. Use powder to set the foundation and give a matte finish.

- **Eyes**

Use light brown or gray on the lid, highlighter under the brow, and a burgundy or other deep shade in the crease of the eye. **BLEND!**

- **Eyebrows**

Use a brow pencil that is slightly darker than your natural color to frame the eye.

- **Eyeliners**

Apply halfway across top lid and under the bottom lashes. Eyes look larger when inner corners are left open.

- **Eyelashes**

Mascara, mascara, mascara! False eyelashes are fine if you use natural looking lashes to enhance your own.

- **Blush**

Brush from side of face toward the mid cheek. Use a rose shade. No red circles. Blend all edges.

- **Lips**

Use a lip pencil to outline lips. Fill in with a deep rose or mulberry color. No bright red or orange shades. Color Suggestions:

- L'Oreal Infallible 312 Rouge Envy (for all skin tones)
- L'Oreal Infallible 362 Plum Bum (for darker skin tones)
- Revlon Ulta HD Matte Lipcolor 635 Passion (for all skin tones)

- **For the Younger Students**

- Use blush, a lip **STAIN**, and eye shadow in the shades listed above.
- Eyebrows - Use a brow pencil a bit darker than your natural color to frame the eye.
- Eyeliner, mascara, false eyelashes, and lip liner **are not needed**.

Bun Tips for Stage

- No bangs or loose strands.
- Use plenty of hair gel and hairspray.
- Bun covers **are not allowed**. Buns should be covered with a hairnet.
- Buns should be positioned at the crown of the head. Start from a mid-high ponytail. Twist hair and pin as you wrap. Hairnets should be pinned around buns. Use hairpins to stick straight in and then under bun. Then spray like crazy!
